## Case Management in Nursing Online Post-Baccalaureate Certificate

The Case Management in Nursing Online Post-
Baccalaureate Certificate Program is a series of
four web-based courses, offered to Baccalaureate
Registered Nurses interested in the practice of
Case Management.

The four courses are delivered online, in seven week intervals, and designed to provide foundational knowledge related to the practice of case management. This certificate program does not provide practice hours to meet national certification requirements. Successful completion of all four courses is required to receive the Case Management in Nursing Post-Baccalaureate Certificate.

## **General Requirements**

By the completion of one semester, BSN Registered Nurses must provide proof of an active unencumbered RN license issued by the state in which they are practicing. This license must be maintained in order for BSN Registered Nurses to progress and receive their certificate.
