STUDENT AGREEMENT FOR PROVISIONAL
ADMISSION AND PARTICIPATION IN THE
DEVELOPMENTAL CO-REQUISITE PROGRAM

Applicants with test scores lower than those required to enter college-level math or English may be admitted to McNeese provisionally, with the agreement that they participate in the Developmental Co-requisite Program.

- Students with one of the following scores may be admitted into the program and enrolled in Math 110 and 113:
- ACT Math 18
- SAT Math Section 480-500
- ACCUPLACER Next Generation Quantitative Reasoning, Algebra, and Statistics 250-262
Students with one of the following scores may be admitted into the program and enrolled in English 100 and 101:
- ACT English 15-17
- SAT Evidence-Based Reading and Writing 440-490
- ACCUPLACER Next Generation Writing 240-249

Students who choose to accept the provisional admission and participate in the program must agree to the following by initialing each item below:

- 1. Enroll in the co-requisite courses for English or math in the first semester of attendance
2. Comply with class attendance expectations. (Attendance will be recorded.)
3. Complete assignments and class participation requirements.
4. Attend periodic meetings with academic advisor to discuss academic performance and class attendance. These meetings may take place at the request of the instructor, academic advisor, or student.
5. Upon successful completion of the co-requisite courses, enroll in a second related General Education course (math or English) the following semester.

STUDENT'S CERTIFICATION: By signing below, I agree to accept the provisional admission to McNeese State University and to participate in the Developmental Co-Requisite Program. I understand that I must comply with items 1-5 as listed above, and that if I fail or withdraw from the co-requisite courses, I may not be able to continue McNeese enrollment in future semesters.
