COURSE ENROLLMENT REQUEST FORM INSTRUCTIONS

You must complete the Course Enrollment Request Form for every term/semester you want to enroll in classes.

Student Instructions:

- Complete Sections I and II on the form.
- Have one parent or custodian print and sign name and date the form.
- Submit the form to your high school counselor. Your counselor will complete the High School Certification section and will submit the form to McNeese.

Parent/Custodian Instructions:

- Sign the form in order for your student to be considered for participation in the High School Dual Enrollment Program.
- Order official scores for your student be sent from the Testing Agency to McNeese ACT reporting #1594 SAT, AP & CLEP reporting # 6403

High School Principal or Counselor Instructions:

Complete the High School Certification section, and then fax, mail, or scan and email it to Madison Owens (see bottom front).

HOW TO APPLY FOR ADMISSION TO THE HIGH SCHOOL DUAL ENROLLMENT PROGRAM

If you have not applied online for admission to the High School Dual Enrollment Program, you must follow the directions below. Step 1: Complete the online application for admission

• Go to www.mcneese.edu and click on Apply in the upper right corner.

- Scroll to the blue Dual Enrollment Students button and click. Read the requirements. Under #2. Apply for Admission select the appropriate term.
- Enter the information to Create a new account: username, email, first name, last name, date of birth, password. Write down your user name & password.
- Log in to your email account and verify your email address via the link provided in the email. (Once you verify your email, you will be brought back to the log in page.)
- Enter your Username and Password under Already have an account? Log in here.
- Follow the prompts and complete all sections of the application. (Make sure you select **High School Dual Enrollment** as the **Student Type**. If this is not a choice, you may be on the wrong application.)

• Once all information has been entered, select the confirmation checkbox on the Statement of Accuracy and Signature tab and submit your application. Step 2: Complete the Course Enrollment Request Form in BLACK INK as outlined above

Step 3: Order official test scores from Testing Agency be sent to McNeese

Step 4: Monitor your email to receive updates about your application

Admissions will communicate with you via email and will notify you if additional information is needed to complete your application.

DUAL ENROLLMENT PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The McNeese State University Dual Enrollment Program allows qualified high school students to enroll in college-level University courses while still enrolled in high school. Students admitted under this program may receive high school credit for University courses as outlined in dual credit agreements between McNeese and participating school boards. Students can be provisionally accepted with school-provided scores, but students must order official scores from the Testing Agency be sent to McNeese. ACT reporting #1594 - SAT, AP & CLEP reporting # 6403 <u>Participation Criteria:</u>

- Must be at least 15 years old
- Must be currently enrolled in the 11th or 12th grade at a public or private Louisiana high school or in a state-approved home school program
- Must be on track for completing the TOPS/University Core Curriculum
- Must be in good standing as defined by the high school
- Must have permission from the high school and his/her parent to participate
- Must have a minimum overall high school GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- If the ACT or SAT has been taken, these minimum composite, English, and math scores must be met and official scores must be sent to McNeese:

Eligibility Criteria to Continue Participation:

To continue enrollment in subsequent semesters/terms through Dual Enrollment, student must:

Maintain a minimum overall high school GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale

- Remain in academic good standing with McNeese as demonstrated by an overall McNeese GPA of 2.0
- Have successfully completed prior Dual Enrollment Program courses (no failing grades)

If the student resigns or withdraws from a course, the student must receive permission from both the high school and college to continue enrollment in subsequent semesters/terms.
