MSU Program Reminders:

Undergraduate Degrees and Additional Certification Areas:

- Elementary and Early Childhood programs have SPED coursework imbedded in their programs. All undergrads in these two programs have to do is take the Praxis exam.

MAT/PBC programs are completely online. These two program candidates are supported throughout their program with coaching and support.

MEd program graduates complete with a Master's degree in Curriculum and Instruction with the following:

- Mentor Teacher Training,
- Field experience hours that can be used toward an EDLD add-on
- Add-on certification area of their chosen concentration.

Dispelling Myths:

- We are not encouraging Alt Cert pathways unless it is in the best interest of a teacher candidate.
- Residency does not add extra hours/cost to program. Hours are just rearranged within the program.

Mentor Teachers:

All Programs at MSU will transition fully to a residency model in Fall 2022. This means that all candidates will need to be placed with a certified Mentor Teacher in order to be issued a Teaching Certificate through the state of Louisiana.

Critical Needs:

- All Secondary Content Areas (English, Math, Social Studies, Science, AG, Music, Art, Business, HHP/PE)
- Early Childhood: Kindergarten

- become an ambassador for the program and the university

REQUIREMENTS

AT ACCEPTANCE

ACT composite score: 22
High school GPA 2.75

IN PROGRAM

- Maintain a 2.75 grade point average
- Maintain full time status and adequate course progression
- Adhere to attendance policies
- Major in Early Childhood or Elementary Education
- Counsel with the following mentors: academic, professional, and MiSTER
- Attend summer Call Me MiSTER Institute

APPLICATION REQUIRES

1. Official high school transcript

2. Copy of ACT or SAT scores

3. Submit two letters of recommendation:

One - from an educator, teacher, principal, or counselor identifying academic potential

One - from a person of the student's choice as personal reference

4. Submit 2 essays:
(250 - 350 words)

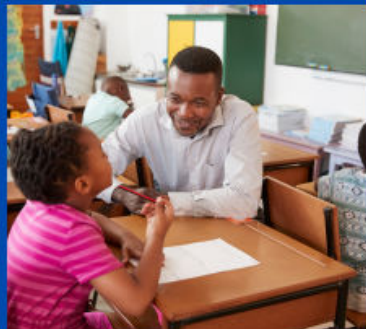
One - Why I Want to Teach
