The Eta Pi Chapter of Order of Omega Greek Honor Society is calling for nominations of junior and senior Greek leaders for fall 2017 inductions. In Order of Omega tradition, a minimal amount of juniors will be selected. Seniors will be selected according to Order of Omega regulations. Nominees must be in good standing with their national organization and the University.

Order of Omega is a national leadership honor society that was founded in 1959 at the University of Miami. Order of Omega has over 500 chapters in North America that recognize students for their scholarship, leadership, character, and service to the Greek, campus and local community. We strive to recognize those fraternity men and women who have attained a high standard of scholarship and leadership in interfraternal activities, to encourage them to continue along this line, and to inspire others to strive for similar conspicuous attainment. McNeese has inducted over 110 students since the chapter was re-chartered in 2017.

Nomination Criteria

- Nominations essays can be submitted by Greeks seeking membership or another chapter member/advisor on behalf of a Greek.
- Only one nomination will be accepted per student.
- Nomination essays should be no longer than 2 pages in length.
- Nominations must explain why a Greek should be accepted into the Eta Pi Chapter. **Please make references to their character, contributions to your Greek organization, contributions to McNeese Greek and Student Life, and contributions to the local community.**
- GPA data will be verified and considered for membership.

Current members of the Eta Pi Chapter will vote to select fall 2017 inductees. **Nominations are due uploaded to the online nomination form by Sunday, November 5, 2017 at 11:59pm.**
