ACCESS Award

For First-Time Freshman and Undergraduate Transfer Students (from a U.S. Institution)

The ACCESS Award, valued at over \$11,000 per year, is renewable each year provided that the student maintains successful academic progress.

Requirements	Value	Who Is Eligible
 A minimum TOEFL score of 71 IBT or IELTS 6.0 For freshman students: a cumulative high school GPA of 2.5 or higher For transfer students: a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher on at least 12 hours of college-level work Readiness for college-level English and math (a minimum of a 19 on the ACT or 500 on SAT Math – OR – equivalent class credit for transfer students) 	\$5,538 per semester	International first-time freshman students Undergraduate transfer (from a U.S. institution)

Only international first-time freshman and undergraduate transfer students (from a United States institution) are eligible for this award.

There is no application for the ACCESS award, since McNeese automatically considers all applicants for this award upon admission.

SPURS Award

For First-Time Freshmen and Undergraduate Transfer Students (from a non-U.S. Institution)

Undergraduate transfer students from foreign universities may qualify for the SPURS Award.

Requirements	Value	Who Is Eligible
 2.5 high school GPA or above OR— 2.5 collegiate GPA or above on at least 24 hours of college work Demonstrated commitment to campus and community engagement intended to promote McNeese school spirit and pride. Requires participation in at least 3 designated campus activities and an in-person interview upon arrival on campus. Additional information regarding leadership and extracurricular participation may be required. Participation in debate, visual arts or dance, music or theater performance, cheerleaders, flag corps, spirit groups or the Student Government Association president 	\$5,538 per semester	All international undergraduate students
