Holidays are declared by the University and approved by the President in accordance with Act 139 of the 1991 Legislative Session, which authorizes 14 paid holidays per calendar year. Any other state holiday that may be declared by the Governor or named in the Civil Service rules will not be observed by the University. Listed below is the approved holiday schedule for 2022 with forced closure dates. The University will observe 14 holidays and 5.5 forced closure days.
