Whereas, the Faculty Senate President has been appointed as a voting member on the committee to find his replacement, and

Whereas, McNeese State University faculty have endured profound professional and economic challenges due to state reductions in public funding of higher education, and

Whereas, the University President will be the primary mechanism of interaction with governing agencies which set both state policy and develop the higher education funding formula, and

Whereas, a formal recruitment and interview process will necessitate focused questions to address faculty needs, and

Now, therefore, be it moved by the McNeese State University Faculty Senate, that

- 1. The Faculty Senate open discussion on the areas and ideal qualities of the incoming McNeese State University President, and
- 2. The Faculty Senate form an *ad hoc* committee to identify essential questions to be asked to prospective candidates.
