To be considered for academic scholarships, you must:

- **Complete the Application for Admission and the Academic Scholarship Application.**
- **Include an unofficial transcript when returning the application. NOTE: For students graduating from state-approved Louisiana high schools on or after May 2003, the paper high school transcript *is not required*. This information will be accessed through the Louisiana Student Transcript System.**
- **Have official ACT/SAT scores forwarded to McNeese State University from the testing company (first-time freshmen only).**
