Sexual Assault Happens... Even Here.

NATIONAL STATS

- The chance of a woman being sexually assaulted during college is about the same as her chance of catching the flu during an average year (according to CDC, risk of catching the flu is 5-20% each year)

NATIONAL STATS

- 95% of campus sexual assaults are unreported (source: US Dept of Justice "the Sexual Victimization of College Women" Research Report)

NATIONAL STATS

- Most rapes are committed by undetected repeat offenders (Source: Lisak & Miller (2002) Repeat Rape and Multiple Offending Among Undetected Rapists)

NATIONAL STATS

- In 90% of cases, the attacker is an acquaintance of the victim (source: US Dept of Justice "the Sexual Victimization of College Women" Research Report)

NATIONAL STATS

- 1 in 5 women is a target of sexual assault while in college (Source: Dept of Justice "The campus Sexual Assault Study")

MCNEESE STATS

- In an anonymous survey of McNeese students in Spring 2016, approximately 1 in 14 reported being sexually assaulted. In 93% of those cases, the attacker was an acquaintance of the victim. None of those assaults were reported to the police.
