How to use MyMcNeese

In order to access your MyMcNeese
you will need to log into your
McNeese account. Once you logged in,
there will be a page filled with
resources that you can use. There is a
link for you to access your outlook,
banner, academic schedule, and
calendar. There are also resources
incase you need to report something
to campus police or need to visit the
counseling center.

How to read your syllabus

When you open up your syllabus on
Canvas, there will be a lot of
information so try not to get
overwhelmed. The most helpful tip for
keeping up with your syllabus is
writing down all your important dates
(test dates, homework deadlines, drop
deadlines, etc.). Your professors'
emails and office hours will also be
found in the syllabus. Some professors
are very particular about how you
email them so be on the lookout to see
if they state how they prefer how
emails are formatted.

How to send an email to your professor

When Sending an email to your professor you want to make sure to include your name, McNeese ID, and which class you are in. This will help the professor identify you and the class you are associated with. you also want to make sure your email is clear. For example if I had a question about an exam coming up in the subject it would say Exams and it would read "Hello, I hope this email finds you well. My name is....ID Number is 000123456. I am a student from your...class and I was wondering when our next exam would be?"

How to join an org or club

There are many different processes to join an organization. One of the best ways to get yourself involved is by talking to a member of the organization or even a member of the executive team. Many organizations are on presence so that is a great place to get started with familiarizing yourself with the different orgs and clubs available at McNeese.
