
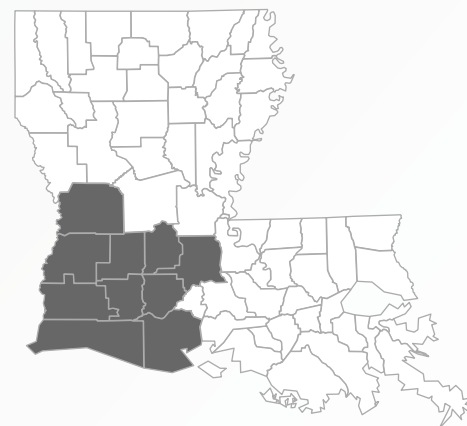

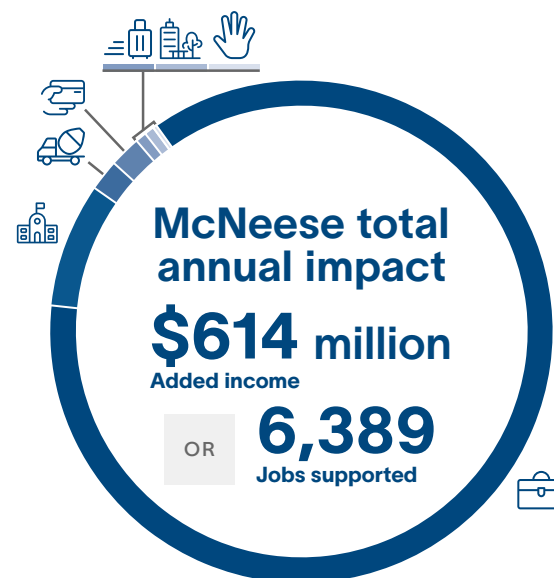

For every \$1...



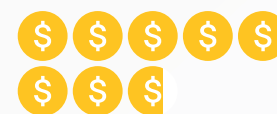
Students gain **\$4.60** in lifetime earnings
